On **Tuesday 27 October**, the International Dairy Federation (IDF) will launch the latest edition of its flagship publication on global dairy markets, the **World Dairy Situation Report 2020** at a special online launch event. This unique publication is produced annually by IDF as part of its mission to represent and support the dairy industry globally.

The 2020 edition is the result of close collaboration between dairy experts and key organisations around the globe and within the IDF.
